## Your Pension Scheme needs your voice

Do you want to have your voice heard on how East Riding Pension Fund (ERPF) runs the Pension Scheme?

An opportunity has arisen for a new representative on ERPF's Local Pension Board and ERPF need people like you to help the Fund continue to improve the services that the Pension Scheme provides.



### You will:

- be a member of the Board consisting of three member representatives and three employer representatives
- have voting rights
- serve for three years
- attend four meetings a year currently held remotely via zoom but normally held in Goole
- be willing to attend induction and training sessions where required
- not be remunerated but travel and subsistence expenses will be paid.

### The role of the Local Pension Board

The Local Pension Board was created for members and employers to help them ensure that the ERPF is well managed. The Board is made up of representatives from both members of the Fund and from our scheme employers.

The Board plays an oversight role, providing comments and suggestions for consideration, which are then considered at our decision making body, ERPF's Pensions Committee. The Board ensures that ERPF is complying with the Local Government Pension Scheme and other relevant regulations including investment and administrative regulations. The role will involve reviewing the financial aspects of pension fund management, including investment elements, and it is desirable that you will have an appropriate level of knowledge. ERPF will provide training, both in house and external, on wide range of topics, including investments, cyber security and the Pensions Regulator.
